HOW TO STRUCTURE IELTS WRITING TASK 2

Option 2 - put your opinions into the 1st body paragraph and concessions into the 2nd

- 1 INTRODUCTION**
Paraphrase the question.
Give your opinion
- 2 BODY 1**
Give your 1st opinion or viewpoint
Provide example and consequence
Give your 2nd opinion
Provide example and consequence
- 3 BODY 2**
Introduce 1st concession + example
Give consequence
Introduce 2nd concession + example
Give consequence
- 4 CONCLUSION**
Summarise your opinions
Provide an overview of the reasons

How to plan Writing Task 2 Opinion questions

Love to Learn English Online recommends that you use an acronym to memorise the structure.
Why not try "Peter Told Oliver That Elephants Eat Cats"?

Intro
Peter - Paraphrase the sentence
Told - Thesis Statement
Oliver - Outline Statement

Body 1 + 2
That - Topic Sentence
Elephants - Explanation Sentence
Eat - Example

Conclusion
Cats - Conclusion
